This information notice on the use of cookies (hereinafter the “**Cookie notice**”) has been drawn up to inform you about the cookies that SOFICO, a public legal entity with headquarters at Rue du Canal de l’Ourthe 9/3, 4031 Angleur, Belgium, registered with the Banque Carrefour des Entreprises under number 0252.151.302 (acting as data controller and hereinafter referred to as “**we, us or our**”, depending on the case) uses via this website (hereinafter, the “**Website**”).

1. INTRODUCTION

Through this Notice, we would like to inform you about how we use cookies.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT COOKIES

Cookies are small electronic text files placed in the browser of your computer (or another digital device used) by the websites that you visit. They are generally used to enable websites to operate or to operate more effectively, as well as to provide information to website owners.

When you visit this Website for the first time, the home page will inform you of this Website's use of cookies and how to consent to their use, via a "cookie banner". If you continue to actively use the Website and you do not actively oppose the use of cookies, you accept our use of cookies and this consent will be stored in your browser, so that the information does not need to be repeated on each page of the Website. If consent is missing in your browser (for example, if you have deleted your cookies), the "**cookie banner**" containing this information will appear again next time you visit the Website. You can configure the use of cookies at any time.



We use cookies that are technically required and do not need your prior consent. We also use session cookies that are automatically deleted at the end of your session and do not need your prior consent either. Other cookies (such as cookies to improve the browsing experience by storing certain data - which avoid you re-entering this data each time you visit - and to adapt the Website content to your preferences) may be installed and used on the basis of your consent.

4. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT GOOGLE ANALYTICS
